Part 3 – Acrylic Bending and Front Panel Work

Hey Folks,

So far we have the main cabinet cut, painted, and secured. It is time to start working on the front face of the dispenser!!

For attaching the front face of the dispenser to the frame, I used Wood insert screws. All you have to do is drill a hole, and then use a screwdriver to seat it. The wood insert and socket head screw is a perfect combination.

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Here is a pic of the mounting plate being dry fitted after being painted

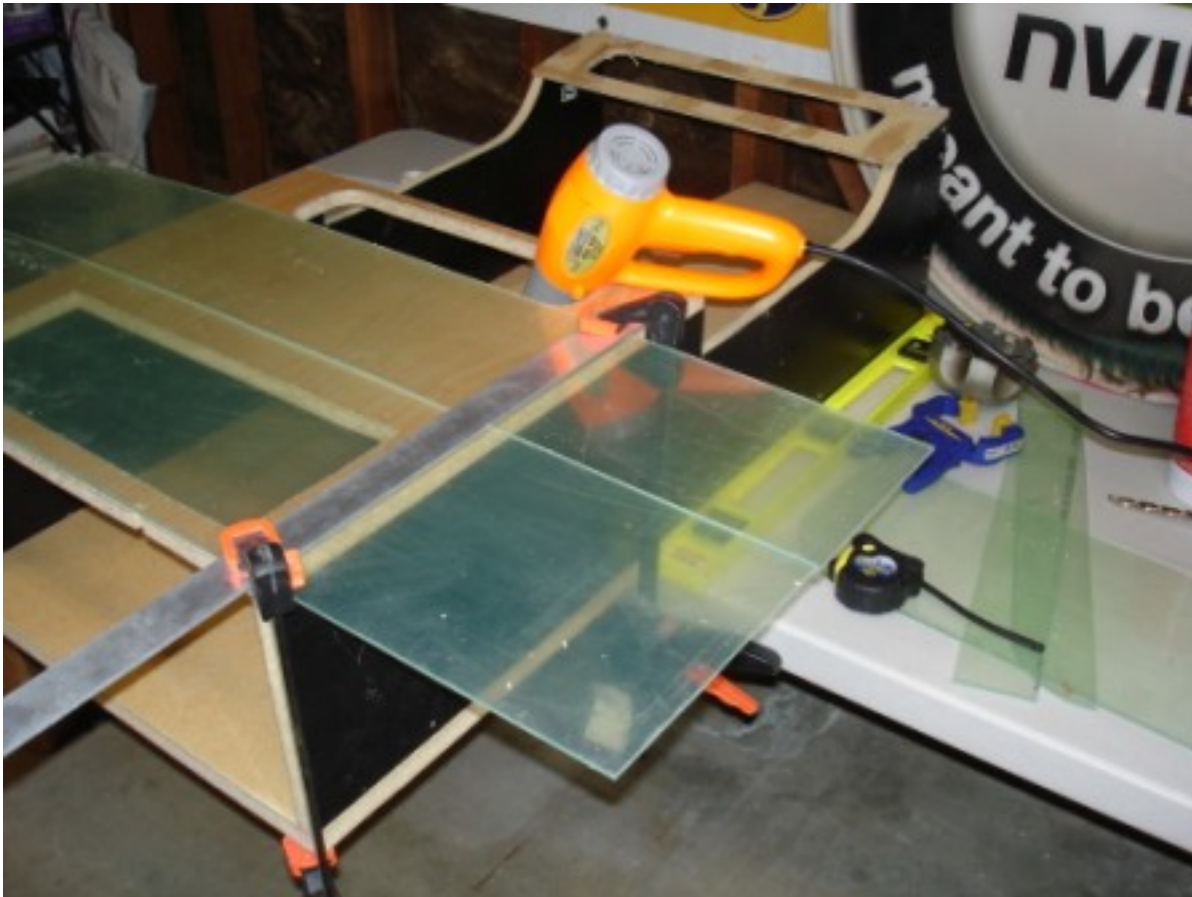


To make the front case was quite easy, I cut two pieces of plexi to size, and use a heat gun to bend it

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To attach the bottom drawer, I attached standard hinges to both the front frame and plexi.

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4mm to access to the video cables and power. I drill a large hole and re-used the desk table
